The aim of the Theoretical Linguistic Research Group is to study from a formal perspective empirical phenomena in Spanish, Romance languages and also some typologically more distant languages. The analyses and proposals developed are framed in various lines of research (lexicon-syntax interface, syntax-semantics-pragmatics interface, aspect, properties of NPs, predication). The utlimate goal is to formulate hypotheses and theories of universal validity within explicit models of grammar. The group also works on the creation and edition of linguistic resources, with special attention to real speech corpus, providing material to support theoretical studies and to integrate into the analysis varieties other than the standard.
